



Bay Model Visitor Center

From the North Bay:

Take Highway 101 SOUTH to the MARIN CITY/SAUSALITO exit at the floor of the Waldo Grade. Make a LEFT at the base of the off-ramp. Make a RIGHT onto BRIDGEWAY. Continue on Bridgeway to HARBOR DR. and make a LEFT. Make the first immediate RIGHT onto MARINSHIP WAY, a small 2-lane street. You will see a small brown and white sign that reads "Bay Model." Follow Marinship for several turns, including a couple of right angle turns. Continue on Marinship until you reach the large building identified as the Bay Model. Make a LEFT into the parking lot. The building entrance is located on the waterside of the building.

From San Francisco/South Bay:

Take Highway 101 NORTH across the Golden Gate Bridge to the MARIN CITY/SAUSALITO exit at the floor of the Waldo Grade. Make a LEFT onto BRIDGEWAY. Continue on Bridgeway to HARBOR DR. and make a LEFT. Make the first immediate RIGHT onto MARINSHIP WAY, a small 2-lane street. You will see a small brown and white sign that reads "Bay Model." Follow Marinship for several turns, including a couple of right angle turns. Continue on Marinship until you reach the large building identified as the Bay Model. Make a LEFT into the parking lot. The building entrance is located on the waterside of the building.

From the East Bay:

Take Highway 80 EAST towards the Richmond/San Rafael Bridge. Cross the bridge to Highway 101 SOUTH. Take the MARIN CITY/SAUSALITO exit at the floor of the Waldo Grade. Make a LEFT at the base of the off-ramp. Make a RIGHT onto BRIDGEWAY. Continue on Bridgeway to HARBOR DR. and make a LEFT. Make the first immediate RIGHT onto MARINSHIP WAY, a small 2-lane street. You will see a small brown and white sign that reads "Bay Model." Follow Marinship for several turns, including a couple of right angle turns.
