



EKG Interpretation

12-Lead EKG Interpretation

This comprehensive course is designed to incorporate 12-Lead EKG interpretation, assessment and recognition of the underlying causes of different heart arrhythmias.

Day 1 emphasis will be placed on: overview of cardiac anatomy and electrophysiology, essential 12-Lead ECG interpretation; acquisition and transmission of 12-Lead; and the identification of acute coronary syndromes.

Day 2 will focus on: how to identify and treat patients specific to Acute Coronary Syndromes; identify those who are candidates for acute reperfusion therapy; identify the highly acute patient and provide an understanding of the anatomical associations that may predict certain complications and direct the therapeutic treatment pathways; and identify bundle branch blocks and the imitators of acute coronary syndromes.
