PEPP - Initial 2 day course

The PEPP course is designed to provide prehospital professionals with the education, skills and confidence necessary to effectively treat pediatric patients. Topics covered will include: Pediatric Assessment Triangle, Child Development, Basic and Advanced Airway Management, Trauma, Child Maltreatment, Respiratory Emergencies, Medical and Cardiovascular Emergencies, Emergency Delivery and Newborn Stabilization, IV Access, Child and Family Interaction, as well as Children with Special Needs.

PEPP is sponsored by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), and meets the minimum standards related to the pediatric portion of the US Department of Transportation (US DOT) National Standard Curriculum for both paramedics and EMT's.
