## Cancellation/Reschedule Policy

If you cancel or do not show up for your class you forfeit the entire course fee. There are no refunds.

You may reschedule only once for a fee. The fee is based on how far in advance you notify us and what type of class you are registered.

For all BLS classes, Healthcare Provider and Heartsaver, and Prep classes you may reschedule only once. With more than 7 days notice the rescheduling fee is \$10. ## ECG Interpretation

### 12-Lead EKG Interpretation

This comprehensive course is designed to incorporate 12-Lead EKG interpretation, assessment and recognition of the underlying causes of different heart arrhythmias.

**Day 1** emphasis will be placed on: overview of cardiac anatomy and electrophysiology, essential 12-Lead ECG interpretation; acquisition and transmission of 12-Lead; and the identification of acute coronary syndromes.

**Day 2** will focus on: how to identify and treat patients specific to Acute Coronary Syndromes; identify those who are candidates for acute reperfusion therapy; identify the highly acute patient and provide an understanding of the anatomical associations that may predict certain complications and direct the therapeutic treatment pathways; and identify bundle branch blocks and the imitators of acute coronary syndromes.
